- 4 As the paediatric consultation liaison psychiatrist, you are asked to assess an 8-year-old child, day 10 following a motor vehicle accident, and who underwent surgery for pelvic fractures 3 days ago. The history is of an acute onset of a change in behaviour, aggression, tearfulness, mood lability, irritability, 'seeing things' and poor sleep. The medical officer is concerned that the child is presenting with a psychiatric disorder and requests admission to the psychiatric ward, upon stabilisation of the medical condition
  - Critically discuss the differential diagnosis of a child presenting with this clinical a) picture. (8)
  - b) What additional information would you want to obtain from the medical records (case notes), ward staff, parent or caregiver?
  - Briefly discuss the main aspects of the assessment and management of this child in c) the general ward setting. (10)
