## **EXAMINATIONS—UPDATES**

## Updated Rules (2021 October, Johannesburg) of the College of Urologists

The rules have now been updated after a 6-month process of discussions, refinement, and consensus agreement that was finalised last year.

#### The key updates are as follows:

The pass mark for the written exam has now been formally increased

As per senate requirements, the oral Veto station been removed

Percentage breakdown has been altered to allow more weighting in the clinical components

Mark allocations have been limited to 4 Questions per exam paper with subset questions usually under 10-15 marks each.

Weighting of the individual written component question components are now heavier.

## Speedwell marking and transition to online e-format examination

In place of the standard paper handwritten exam format the College of Urologists will be utilising an online typed platform. This will be conducted in a controlled monitored CMSA venue. We thank the Prof V Burch and all the examination personnel who have ensured this transition to be a smooth one. This progressive move to conduct the examination in an electronic format ('written' and marked) results in less postal delays and provides instant marker access with immediate result transmission to the allocated Convenor and Moderator. The implementation of this method has proven to be successful over the previous 2 FC Urol examinations and the College of Urologists will be adopting this format for all future examinations, moving forward.

### Examiners and Observers—"House Rules"

The examination process takes a lot of preparation, commitment, and valuable time from Examiners/Exam Panel members. As a constituent College we strive to put forward a well-represented panel. To achieve **Examiner status** an individual (Specialist Urologist) should observe for at least one Full prior examination (including the Clinical and all other Oral/ Online components).

Each exam will allow for at least 2-4 Observers depending on if online / in person. Academic HODs are encouraged to put forward Observers who have good standing and at least 5 years of Clinical Experience post **FC Urol (SA)** qualification. It is usual practice and expected that consultants from all Academic Centres in South Africa will be inducted into the College as Examiners, after 5 years within their post. Private Urologists are also encouraged to volunteer their time and experience examining - via their nearest/local University Academic HOD/nearest Council Member.

## **Registrar Masterclass (#SAUREM)**

### The South African Urology Registrar Education Masterclass

After the 'pilot' program in 2019, In collaboration with the SAUA Academic Subcommittee, this national teaching event will be another established event on the annual CMSA Urology Registrar Education calendar and will be held mid-year to allow senior registrars the Exam Preparation needed prior to finals.

The SAUREM event includes a weekend of Mock OSCES, Invited Lectures, a formal online MOCK written examination with an immediate instant online output result

Thanks to the current pledged sponsorship from **Nu Angle and Karl Storz** for the transportation and accommodation of Urologists and Urology registrars for this event. We are also indebted to the SAUA (South African Urological Association) for their assistance in this regard.

Regarding the Consultant and registrar attendance, we are ensuring representation and national involvement via the Academic HODs across South Africa.
